If she had not got stuck on the tree, I would not have taken the ladder to climb it.

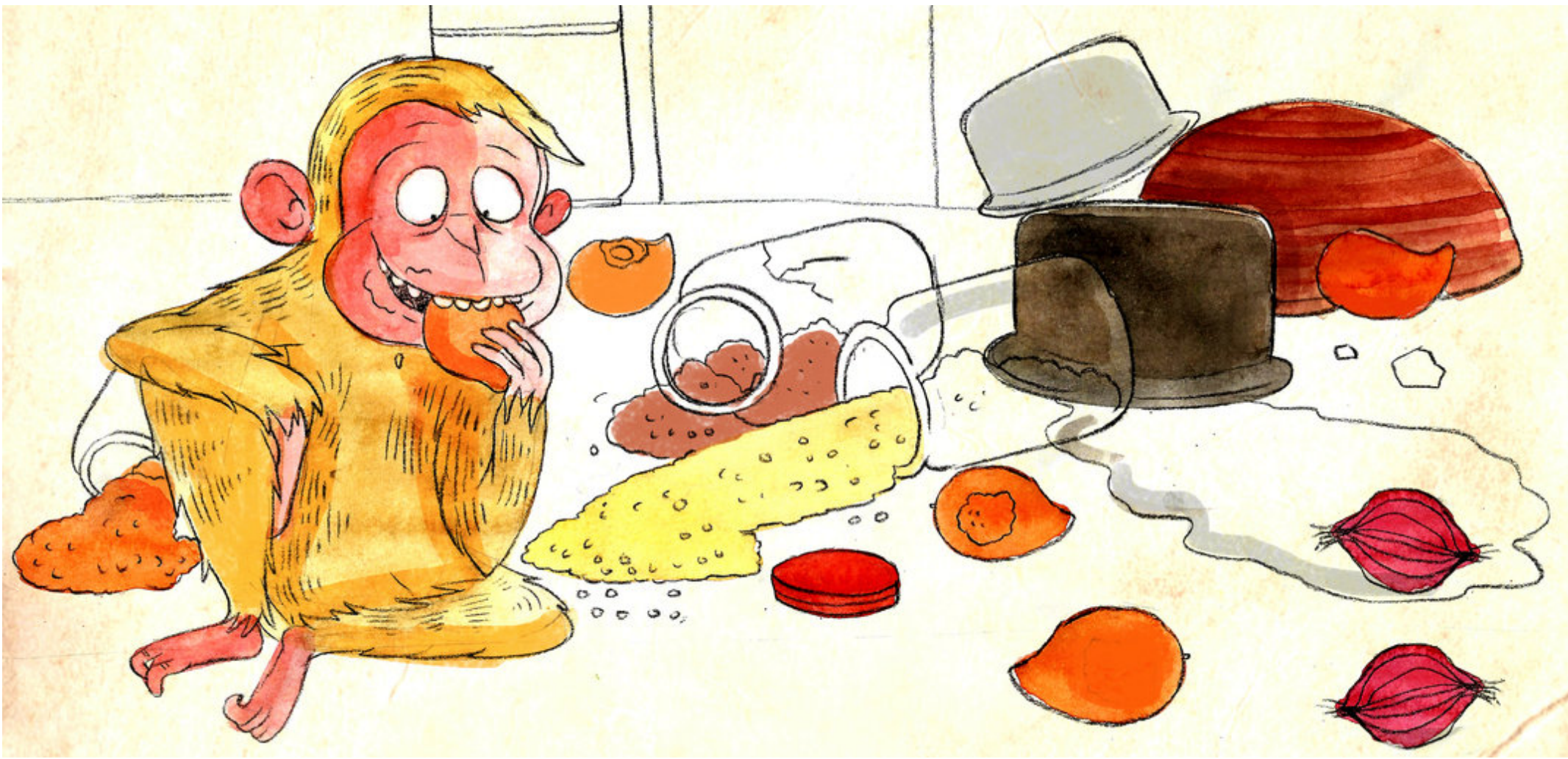

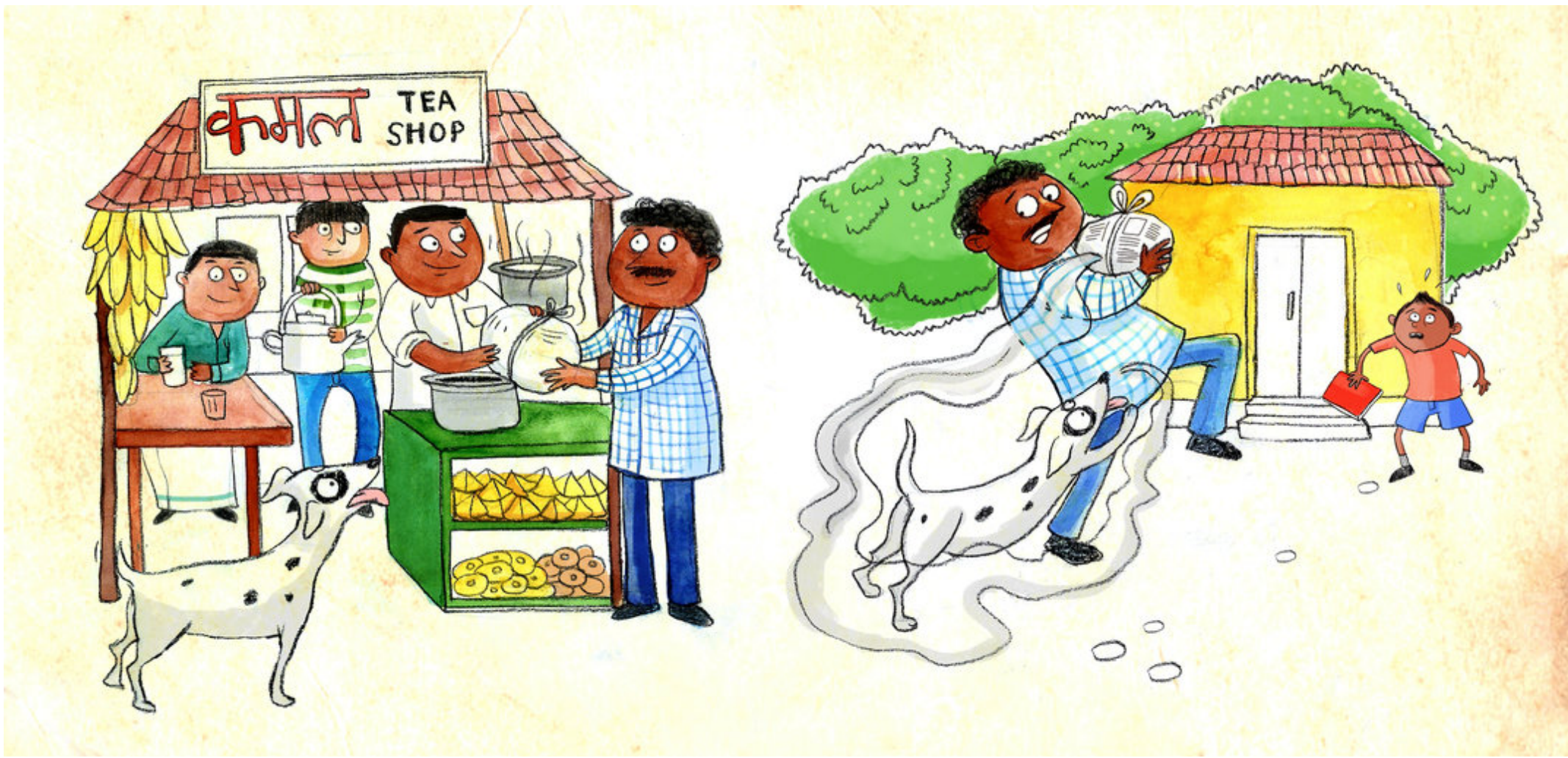
If I had not needed to fix it, I wouldn't have woken up the baby.

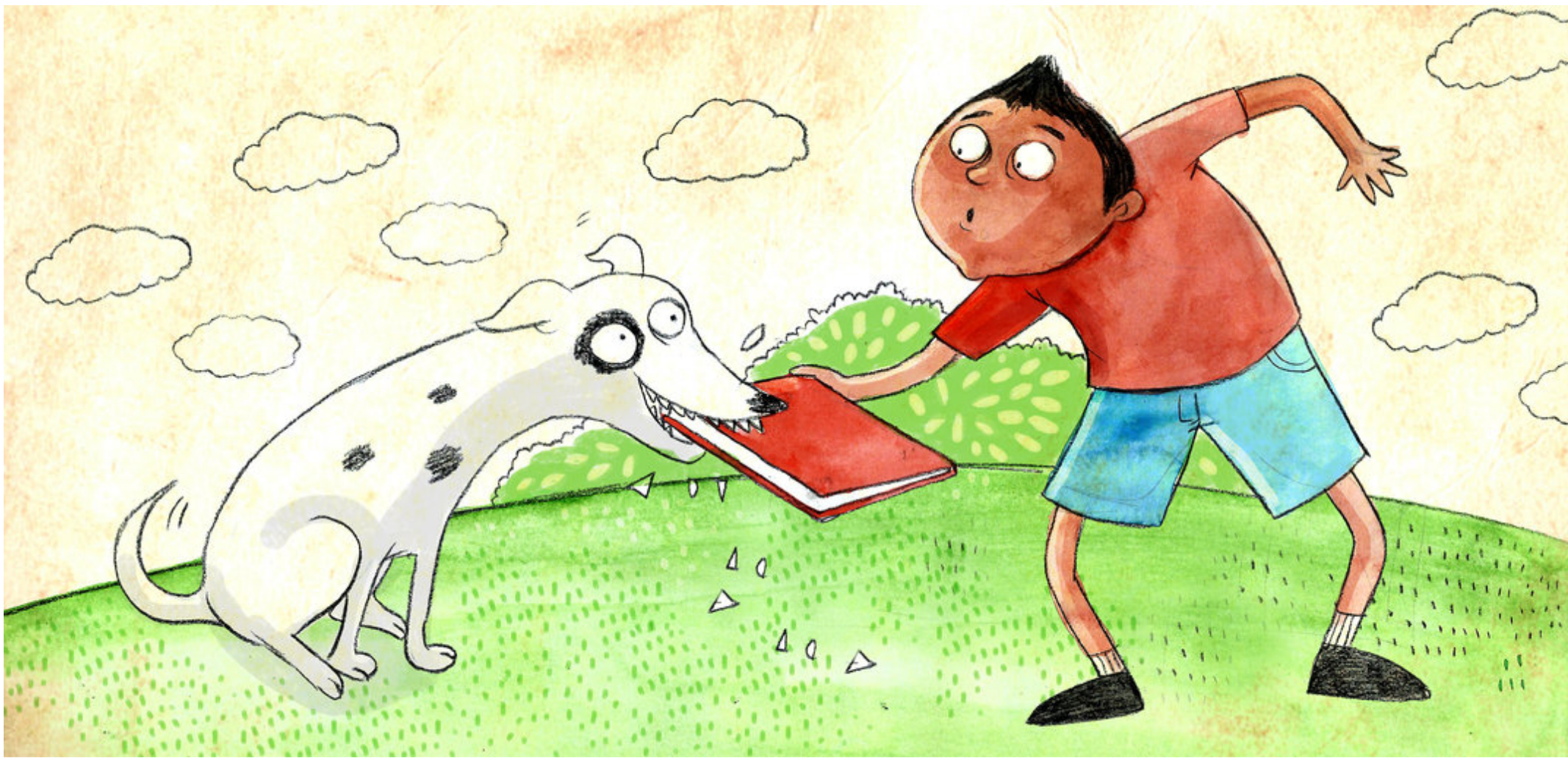
