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
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













Wondering what's up with stories without letters?

It has endless possibilities. Here are some ideas:

Let's understand the story slowly. Pay attention to the details of the story, such as the expressions of the characters, the background, the colors etc. Each child will create his own story based on these pictures. Show a group of children these pictures and ask them to add a sentence or two to each picture. A good story will be made by passing through each line.

This can be used to start a discussion by asking the children what each child will do for their birthday.





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
